# Our Preschooler Programs



Ages: 2-5



READY SET DANCE is a combo class that includes Jazz, Tap, Hip Hop, Singing, and Music, designed for both boys and girls to teach the fundamentals of dance while fostering CONFIDENCE, COORDINATION, and CREATIVITY in a professional and safe environment. In Dance, children develop coordination, body awareness, strength, and flexibility through visual and auditory instruction.



Ages: 2-5



READY SET BALLET is a magical ballet experience, introducing children aged 2-5 years to the fundamentals of classical ballet. The curriculum fosters coordination, body awareness, strength, and flexibility using visual and auditory instruction. Young dancers will explore their creativity and build confidence as they embark on imaginative adventures.



Ages: Walking-5



READY SET MOVE is a creative movement and music class for toddlers from walking to 3 years of age, along with their grown-ups. The class consists of three sections: ENGAGE, EXPLORE, and EXPRESS. Participating in READY SET MOVE with the support of a grown-up can significantly contribute to play, development, and learning, so come and bounce like a bunny, be slow like a sloth, and create lasting memories with your special little mover.



Ages: 2-5



READY SET ACRO is a collaborative acrobatic program developed with Industry Leader Acrobatic Arts, specifically designed for preschoolers. It emphasizes safe and effective progressions to foster the physical and social skills needed for healthy early childhood development. The program features original music with lyric cues and focuses on three key components: STRETCH, STRENGTH, and SKILLS.

### Super Combo (2 Hours):

The \$39 Super Combo rate applies when a dancer is enrolled in one 60-minute Ready Set Dance class and two 30-minute Ready Set Dance classes. Fees must be paid on time to be eligible for discounted combo pricing.

## PAYMENT INFO

**Payment of all accounts is due within three weeks of the term start date.**

- Invoices are emailed to the parent/guardian nominated at the time of enrolment.
- Fees are payable for the full term once enrolled and are not reduced for absences due to illness or holidays.

### Payment Plans & AutoPay

Payment plans are available through AutoPay via your studio app.

When AutoPay is selected, term invoices are divided into fortnightly payments. All fees must be paid in full by the end of the term.

Payments made via the app are receipted instantly. Manual bank transfers may take up to two weeks to be receipted.

### Late Fees

If fees have not been settled within 14 days of the due date, a \$10 late fee will be applied.

An additional \$5 per fortnight will be charged thereafter until the account is brought up to date.

- Families with an active AutoPay payment plan will not incur late fees, provided scheduled payments are successfully processed. Late fees may apply if AutoPay payments fail or are declined.

### Account Enquiries

For all fee or payment enquiries, please contact the studio directly - Jenny or Aimee. Discussing account matters with teaching staff during class time is discouraged.

### Debt Recovery

Accounts significantly overdue may be referred for debt recovery, with any associated costs passed on to the account holder.

# Uniform



All students must wear the official Ready Set Dance uniform.

- Girls: Pink frill dress - tan shoes for RSD, Pink for RSB
- Boys: Blue Ready Set top with black bottoms - black shoes
- Correct dance shoes required - as shown below

- Purple Ready Set Move T-shirt
- Optional tutu

Uniform requirements follow Ready Set Dance guidelines and differ from standard studio uniform policies.

# Terms & Conditions



## Studio Policies

To ensure the best dance experience possible for your child, please read and become familiar with our studio policies.

### General etiquette

At Dance Devotion, we aim to create a welcoming, respectful, and supportive environment for all dancers, families, and staff. We kindly ask that children and adults treat teachers, classmates, and studio facilities with care and respect at all times. Parents and guardians are requested to follow studio procedures and support a calm and positive learning atmosphere.

### Attendance

Regular attendance is encouraged to help children feel confident, settled, and comfortable in class. If your child is unable to attend a lesson, please notify the studio where possible. Missed classes due to absence are not refundable; however, we understand that young children may need time to adjust and appreciate your communication.

### Health of students

For the wellbeing of all dancers and staff, children should not attend class if they are unwell or contagious. This includes fever, vomiting, diarrhoea, or other infectious conditions. If your child has any medical conditions, allergies, or special requirements, please ensure these are noted in the Parent Portal so our teaching team can provide appropriate care and support.

### Student/instructor interaction

Our teachers are committed to providing a safe, nurturing, and encouraging learning environment. Physical guidance may be used in a gentle and age-appropriate manner to support correct movement and participation. All interactions between students and instructors are conducted professionally and in line with child-safe practices.

### Drop off/pick up

For Ready Set Dance classes, parents or guardians must ensure children are safely delivered to and collected from the studio on time. Children should remain under parental supervision before and after class unless otherwise advised. Please notify the studio if someone different will be collecting your child.

### Communication

Important studio information, updates, and reminders are shared via email, newsletters, the Parent Portal, and our private Facebook group. We ask families to ensure contact details are kept up to date so communication is received promptly.

### Queries & feedback

We value open and respectful communication. If you have any questions, concerns, or feedback, please contact the studio directly via email or phone. We are always happy to assist and work together to ensure the best experience for your child.



# Terms & Conditions



## Car park rules

For the safety of all families, children must be supervised at all times in the car park and surrounding studio areas. Please hold your child's hand when entering or exiting the premises and be mindful of vehicles at all times. Parking spaces are to be used respectfully, and driveways and access points must remain clear.

## Class etiquette

To support a positive learning environment, we ask that all dancers arrive on time, ready to participate, and follow teacher instructions during class. Parents and guardians are requested to observe quietly where applicable and allow teachers to manage the class without interruption. Respectful behaviour towards teachers, classmates, and studio property is expected at all times.

## Ready Set Dance Uniform

Ready Set Dance classes follow the official Ready Set Dance uniform guidelines, which may differ from standard studio uniform requirements. Wearing the correct Ready Set uniform supports consistency, confidence, and participation within the program. Families will be provided with uniform information upon enrolment, and we appreciate your support in ensuring dancers attend class in the correct attire.

## Studio Discretion

Dance Devotion reserves the right to make decisions in the best interests of students, staff, and the overall studio environment. This includes, but is not limited to, class placement, timetable adjustments, enrolment limits, uniform expectations, and behavioural matters.

## Additional Notes

Policies are in place to ensure a safe, positive, and enjoyable experience for all families. By enrolling, families agree to adhere to studio policies and procedures as outlined in this information pack and any updates communicated by the studio.



# FAQ's



## Can I watch my child's classes?

In our experience preschoolers are able to concentrate better without the distraction of other noise in the room from parents and other siblings. Our program has been endorsed by leading child care experts who support the independent learning model. As preschoolers participate in classes they have the opportunity to develop additional secure attachments with adults (teachers) and peers. This helps them transition positively into the larger world and helps with school readiness.

Having said that, a lot of children are timid at first and need to know that a parent is close by. Our program allows parents to watch the first class if necessary to help them adjust.

## Are your teacher's qualified?

All teachers have their Working with Children Check and follow the program that is endorsed by early learning experts. Ready Set Dance teachers are required to gain their certification from Ready Set Dance head office before delivering the program and regularly attend training.

## Do we need to purchase uniform and shoes?

Students must wear the Ready Set Dance uniform. However, we need to make sure we are the right fit for you and your child before committing to anything. Comfortable clothes and sneakers are fine for the first couple of lessons. Once your child has settled you can purchase the official Ready Set Dance uniform at reception which we are sure you will love.

## What is watching day?

Watching day is where parents get to view their child dance as an audience in the classroom. It's a chance for your child to begin their first step to working on their performance skills. You will be notified of parent watching week when it is happening!

## If we miss a class can it be made up on another day of the week?

You may swap days during Terms 1, 2 and 3 if you miss a class (as long as the make up class is not full). In term 4, each class works on a different routine for the end-of-year concert, and it is too confusing for students to be swapping days. We do recommend that you avoid alternating days too much as preschoolers need the comfort of knowing that the same teacher and their friends will be there when they go to dancing.

## How can I experience Ready Set Dance at home?

Ready Set Dance airs on Nick Jr and Paramount Plus. You can also catch us on YouTube and the Nick Jr Play App. The Show has been so popular that it is now airing in 120 countries all over the world. Preschoolers love to dance along to their favourite songs from the TV show in their classes every week.
